San Francisco (February 27, 1998) — Sun Microsystems Inc. has named Alexander Galitsky as its new CEO, a Russian software developer who is beginning to distance himself from Sun. 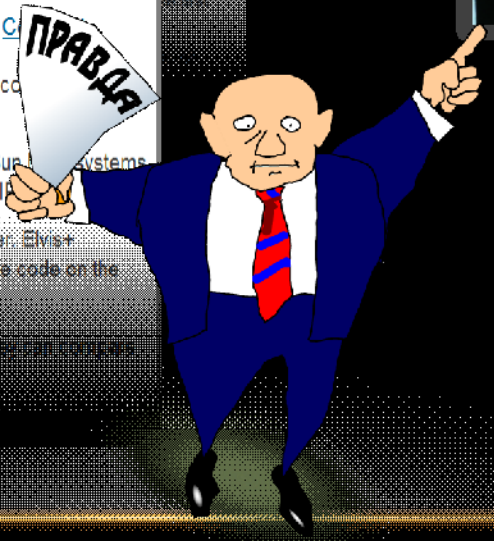

Mountain View, Calif.: The National Security Agency is nothing but a hound dog when it comes to encryption.

The government agency has asked Elvis+, the Russian networking company in which Sun Microsystems Inc. has a 10 percent stake, and Sun to turn over the source code of its SunScreen SKIP E+ encryption software.

At press time, Sun and the NSA still were negotiating over what code Sun must turn over. Elvis+ President and Chief Executive Alexander Galitsky has refused to turn over all the source code on the grounds that the government does not need it.

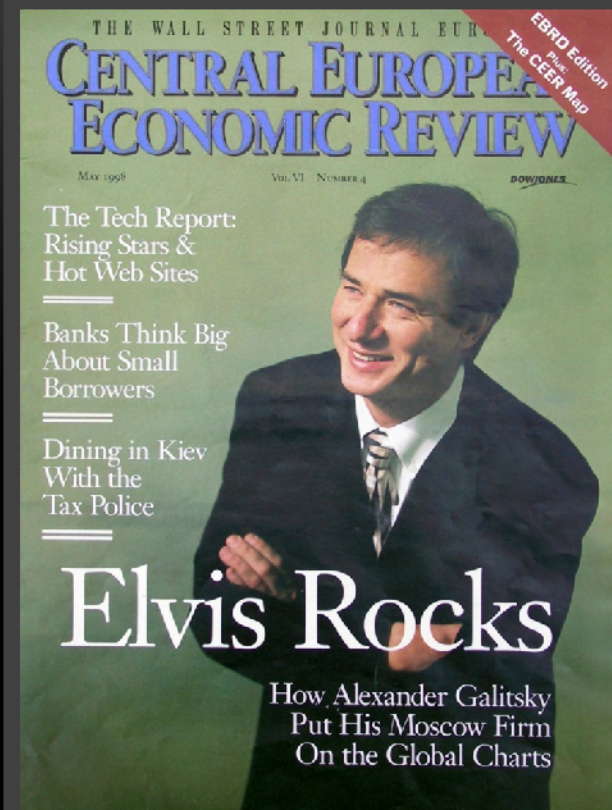
Sun finds loophole in U.S. encryption policy by licensing Russian software

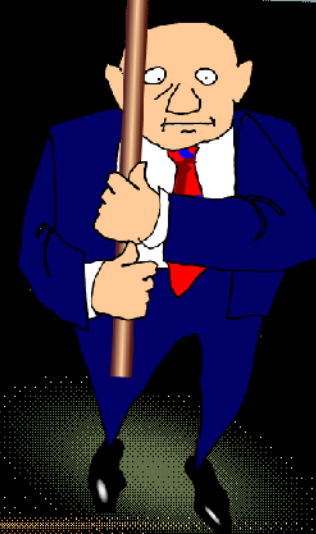
San Francisco (May 20, 1997) -- Sun Microsystems Inc. is stepping up the pressure on the U.S. government to change its encryption policy, industry observers say, by becoming the first major U.S. company to offer software capable of 128-bit encryption for sale outside of the United States.

Sun announced yesterday that it will license software capable of up to 128-bit cipher, and 2048-bit integrity, triple DES (Data Encryption Standard Fortezza) encryption, and other cryptographic services to Russian, European, and Japanese customers.

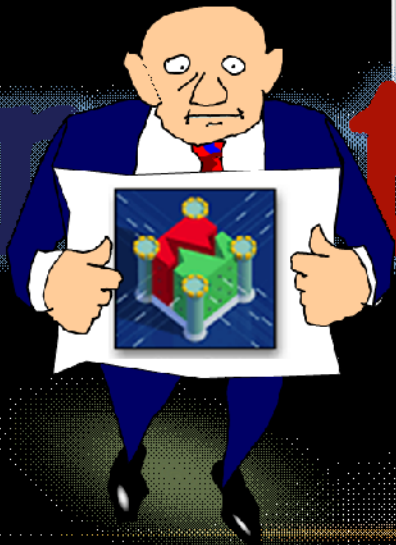

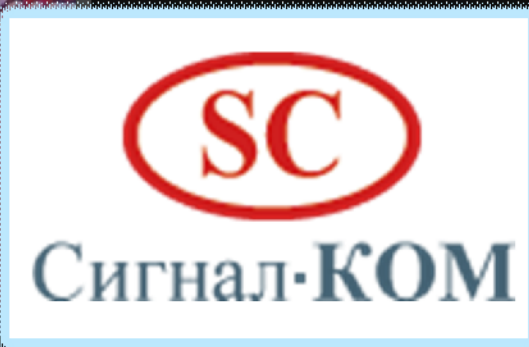

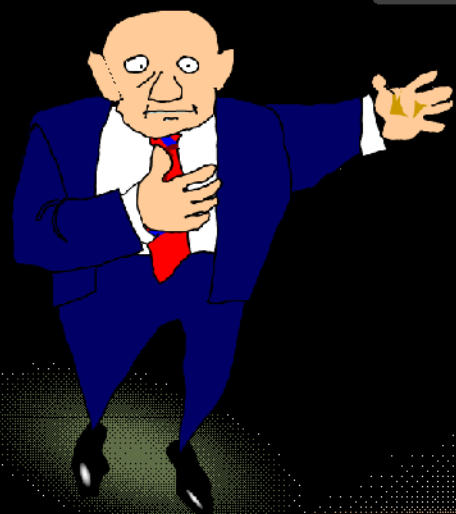
